### **Loring Park Master Plan Request for Proposal**

CLPC's Master Plan Steering Committee has been working diligently to develop a Scope of Services, Timeline, Selection Criteria, and project area. This information is being compiled into a Request for Proposal. CLPC will be looking for applicants to respond to the posted RFP. The Consultant Team selected will work with the Steering Committee & Community to create our Master Plan. Once completed, the Master Plan will be adopted by the City of Minneapolis and the Metropolitan Council. We anticipate that the RFP will be posted Spring of 2010, with Selection process to occur early summer. The Master Plan and Community Engagement process is projected to run from Fall of 2010 through Spring of 2011. Look for more details in upcoming Newsletters!!
