


Citizens for a Loring Park Community Survey 2025 Summary of Results


The annual survey of Loring Park residents received 101 responses, and a vast majority of participants identified as Loring Park residents, with a smaller segment representing businesses, those who work in the neighborhood and organizations. A significant portion of respondents are long-term residents, with notable numbers having lived in the area for over 20 years, followed by those in the 0-5 year and 5-10 year ranges. Most residents rent their living spaces, while businesses are more likely to own their premises.




Do you rent or own? If you're a business, do you rent or own your space?




Concerns & Suggestions






How often do you use Loring Park?

How respondents use the park:


Park Use


